Welcome to the EnergyWeek 2025 Matchmaking!

The annual Vaasa EnergyWeek is the largest energy cluster event in the Nordic countries, focusing on renewable energy, smart energy, clean gas energy and energy storage. Topics of interest include digitalization, batteries and storage, circular economy, future smart cities, energy regulation, business and innovation.

Enterprise Europe Network organizes a free-of-charge onsite B2B matchmaking event during the EnergyWeek. The matchmaking welcomes companies and experts from all sectors of the energy industry.



Before the event - Register

First, create a b2match account or login with an existing account


Then, register a participant profile to the event:

- Personal information (pitch, biography, skills, interests, social media links)
- What kind of partners are you looking for?
- Organization information (join an existing organization or create a new one)

Once registered, on the dashboard remember to

- Create opportunities (showcase on Marketplace what you offer or look for)
- Plan your attendance your availability to have meetings (My Availability)

Describe clearly in your participant profile what you are looking for and what you can offer to potential partners. The better the participant profile, the more meaningful meetings you will have in Vaasa!





Before the event – Book meetings


Check Participants and Marketplace to find interesting participant profiles and send meeting invitations to those you wish to meet in Vaasa.

- Select the most suitable timeslot for the meeting. The matchmaking system takes into account the availability of both the participants. If you cannot find a suitable timeslot, check your availability for meetings.
- You can add/invite more participants to the meeting, there can be four participants in one meeting.
- Add introduction to the meeting invitation, why you think you should meet.

You can also bookmark interesting participants and send messages to other participants via the matchmaking system.



Accept/decline the meeting invitations you receive, as only accepted invitations are scheduled to your meeting agenda and reserved a timeslot and table in the matchmaking area.






Before the event – Prepare well

To make the most of the event, prepare well for the meetings!

You can always check your personal meeting agenda online on the event website (Meetings) or in the mobile application.

The meeting agenda includes information about

- the status of the meeting (accepted, pending, canceled)
- who you will meet,
- at what time, and
- the table number where the meeting will take place.





At the matchmaking


The pre-scheduled 20-minute 1to1 meetings take place on the 4th floor of the Vaasa City Hall – the accepted meeting invitations are scheduled and reserved a timeslot & table in the matchmaking area.

Respect your meeting partner's schedule and be on time for the meeting.

If for some reason you cannot join the meeting, please inform your meeting partner and the organizers.

Exchange contact information with your meeting partners, to agree on next steps, you can also send messages via the matchmaking website and mobile application b2match.

The matchmaking organizers are there to help you throughout the event.








After the event


Rate the meetings you had. The meeting rating can be done via Notifications or Meetings.
